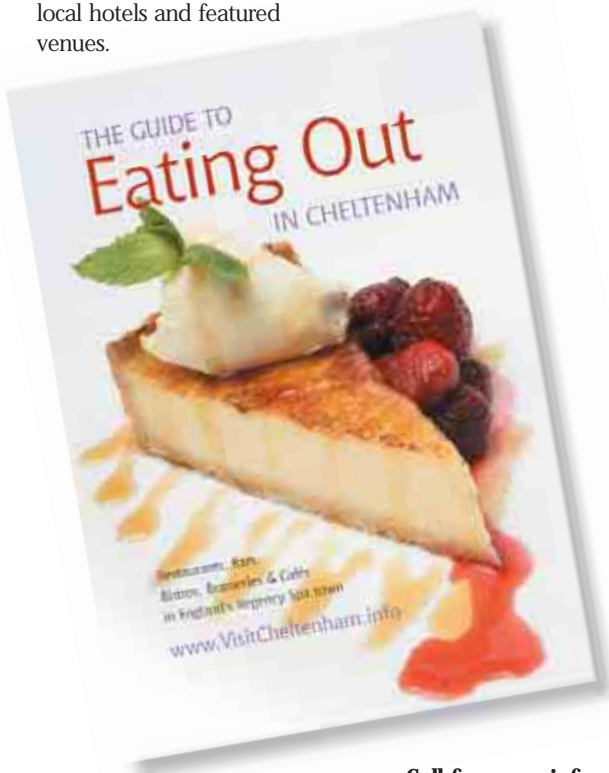
The Regency Spa Town, famous for its waters, invites you to sample its other watering holes and stylish restaurants
